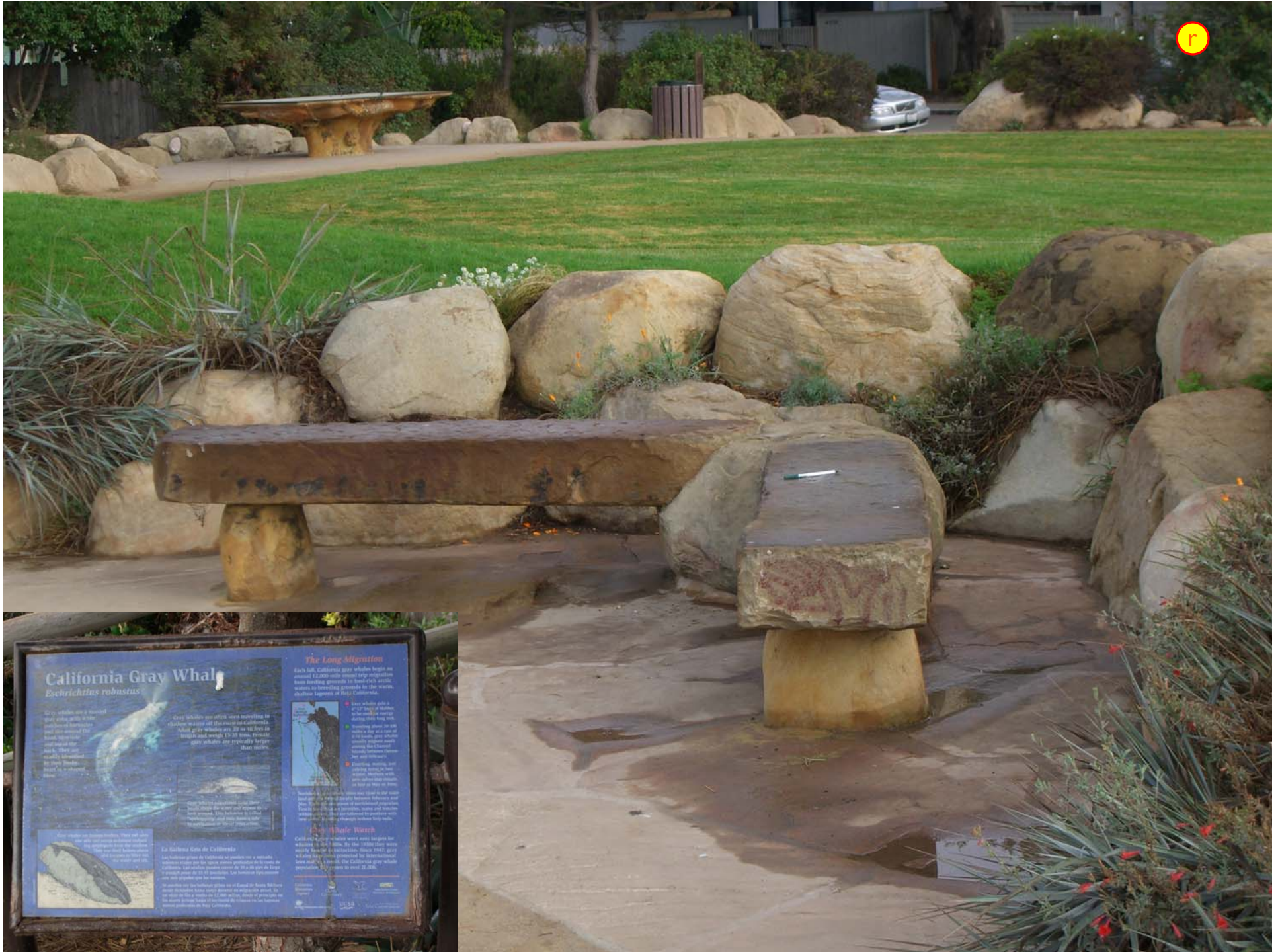

California Gray Whale

Eschrichtius robustus



Gray whales are a beautiful, ancient whale species that have survived the last ice age and are still found in the North Pacific Ocean.

Gray whales are often seen breaching the surface of the water. They can reach a length of 30 meters and weigh 30 tons. Female gray whales are typically larger than males.

The Long Migration

Each fall, California gray whales begin the annual 12,000 mile round trip migration from feeding grounds in food-rich Arctic waters to breeding grounds in the warm, shallow lagoons of Baja California.

- Gray whales give a 40-50 day gestation period to the mother whale.

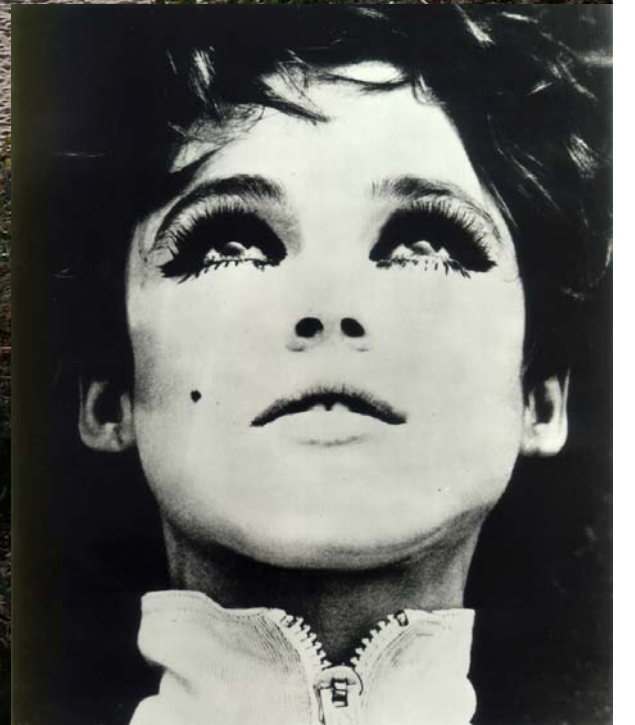

CAMINO CORTO OPEN SPACE-HISTORY

Native American people, known as Chumash, lived in this area for thousands of years. They gathered native plants for food, medicines and shelter, and collected seafood from the ocean, and from two nearby estuaries, now called Corona Slough and Devereux Lagoon.

Since 1995, this land has been set aside for nature and history, owned by all companies, and protected for housing. The land was protected with Coastal Resource Enhancement Funds and designated as Camino Corto Open Space, and is now owned and managed by the Isla Vista Recreation and Park District.
